Sir,

In continuation to Central Council of Homoeopathy’s letter dated 18.07.2018, wherein a Letter of Intent was issued to the Sanskruti Education and Charitable Trust to start a new Homoeopathic Medical college name and style “Bhargva Homoeopathic Medical College, Anand, Gujarat with 100 seats, in BHMS course from the academic session 2018-19 subject to fulfillment of certain conditions, I am directed to say that after careful consideration of your proposal in terms of the provision of the HCC Act 1973, relevant regulations, inspection report and recommendation of the CCH and policy of this Ministry for granting conditional permission; **permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to the Sanskruti Education and Charitable Trust to start a new Homoeopathic College in the name of Bhargava Homoeopathic Medical College, Annad, Gujarat with 100 seats in BHMS (UG) Course from the academic session 2018-19 under the provision of the section 12A of the HCC Act 1973.**

2. The college administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teaching faculty, non-teaching staff, hospital staff and other requirements as per the provision of HCC (MSR), 2013 Regulations are in position before the admission of the first batch of students in the 1<sup>st</sup> professional BHMS course is made, under intimation to the Central Government and CCH.

3. The college has to develop the requisite infrastructure for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and 4<sup>th</sup> BHMS course well in time as per the CCH norms which will be verified and reported by the CCH at least three months before the start of next professional and accordingly, the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be issued.

4. The college administration may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under section 13(1) of the HCC Act, 1973 at that time when the first batch of students admitted against this course appears for the first final professional examination of the said course.
