Sub: Application for Letter of permission for functioning of Bhargva Homoeopathy Medical College, Vidyagram, At & Post-Dahemi, Ta – Borsad, Dist. Anand, Gujarat - 388560 for Admission in BHMS Course with Intake Capacity of 100 seats for academic year 2025-26– reg.

Sir/Madam,

Bhargva Homoeopathy Medical College, Vidyagram, At & Post-Dahemi, Ta – Borsad, Dist. Anand, Gujarat - 388560 has submitted an application for permission for sanction of 100 seats in BHMS course for the academic year 2025-26. MARBH conducted Inspection on 20.06.2025 and 21.06.2025. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards as per the prevailing regulations. On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board observed the following shortfalls:

A. Hospital Functioning:

- Average OPD is 264 which is not as per MES, 2024 Regulations.
- IPD case sheets were incomplete.
- In OPD case records, diagnosis did not match with the symptoms. Also, no examination was done.
- Deputy Medical Officer not available.

B. Teaching Faculty:

- Anatomy Department: Assistant Professor 01 not available.
- Physiology Department: Associate Professor 01 not available.
- Pathology Department: Associate Professor 01 not available.
- Community Medicine Department: Professor 01 and Associate Professor 01 not available.

As evident from the above statement, a total number of five teachers are deficient against the requirement of 40+1 for 100 seats UG college (As specified in MES, 2024). Pursuant to F.No. :3-2/MARBH/NCH/2025-26/162-169 dtd. 16/04/2025 issued by MARBH, a college can avail 10% relaxation against the required number of teachers for academic year 2025-26 only. After allowing relaxation of 10%, college still has deficiency of one teacher. However, such a relaxed number of teachers should also be appointed at the earliest for smooth conduct of course

A. Miscellaneous: Salary of staff is not as per MES, 2024 Regulations.

2. Considering the above observations during inspection, MARBH has decided to issue **conditional permission to Bhargva Homoeopathy Medical College, Vidyagram, At & Post-Dahemi, Ta – Borsad, Dist. Anand, Gujarat - 388560 for Admission in BHMS Course with Intake Capacity of 100 seats for the academic year 2025-26 on basis of following conditions:**

- i. Hospital shall be functioning as per MES, 2024 Regulations.
- ii. Salary of staff should be as per MES, 2024 Regulations.
- iii. Teaching faculty 01 shall be appointed within 30 days.


Deficiencies mentioned above shall be rectified within a period of 30 days and the compliance report shall be submitted to the undersigned, failing which conditional permission issued will be withdrawn without further notice

3. All admissions shall be made from NEET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of UG seats shall be treated as All India Quota. Counselling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective Counselling Authority of State/UT govt as designated by Central Government and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counselling authority of the state/UT.

4. The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.
